Wipe disinfection

1. Manual cleaning and disinfection

Pay attention that all contaminated surfaces are completely moistened for the complete exposure time specified by the disinfectant manufacturer. If necessary, increase the number of wiping procedures and/or the number of wipes.

Equipment

- Disinfectant: Fugaten-Spray (Lysoform-Spry), alternative: Esemfix by Schülke, Promanum pure by Braun, Meliseptol Foam pur by Braun.
- For maintaining the elasticity of the tube and other non-metallic components, we using a recommend a vinyl-care roducts.

Implementation

- Clean and disinfect the device manually.
- Pay particular attention to difficult to access areas.
- Thoroughly wipe the touched areas.
- Then wipe with a cloth soaked in clean water.
- For removing the disinfectant and drying afterwards, follow the instructions provided by the disinfectant manufacturer.

2. Inspection and function testing

- Check the device for any visible contaminants. Reprocess again if necessary.
- Do not use the device if there are visible signs of damage.

3. Storage

Store it in such a way that it is protected from recontamination, dust and moisture.
